Nature Activities:

Unstructured play time in nature is highly valuable for young children. Take your child outdoors if possible and ask them what they see or hear in nature. ENGAGE THEIR CURIOSITY!

Activity ideas:

- Explore the flowers and plants around your home/park.
- Discuss how birds and bees pollinate the flowers.
- Look for birds or bees.
- Climb a tree! (as age appropriate)
- See if any area parks or nature centers have nature programs for young children.

Ask children what they see or hear related to the story.

Examples of questions to ask:

"Let's look for a tulip!" (as appropriate)

"What is your favorite color flower?"

"How can birds and flowers be friends?"
